THE TRIENNIAL GENERAL BODY CONFERENCE & A HISTORIC EVENT OF GRAND FINALE OF GOLDEN JUBILLEE CELEBRATIONS

The Triennial General Body Conference & Grand Finale of Golden Jubilee Celebrations of "All India Central Bank Officers' Federation" (AICBOF) was held at Balgandharva Rang Mandir, Pune on 31st January & 1st February 2015. A grand rally of the delegates / observers and local officers to the conference venue marked the commencement of inauguration function. The colorful procession of nearly 700 comrades started from Deccan gymkhana in a disciplined manner. All the 21 units of the Federation with banners in their hand thundering slogans of "AICBOF ZINDABAD", "BANK OFFICERS' UNITY ZINDABAD", "AICBOF LONG LIVE" attracted the attention of Puneits surrounded and followed by Press & e media created an air of TRADE UNION atmosphere in the city.

The beautifully decorated Conference Hall with catchy flowers & posters was a matter of attraction & applause for the gathering. The dignitaries on the dias included Shri. Prakash Jawadekarji, Union Minister for Environment, Forest & Climate Change; Shri Harvinder Singh, General Secretary AIBOC and Shri. R.C.Agarwal, Ex President AIBOC & Ex General Secretary AICBOF. The dignitaries on the dias proceeded for the traditional event of lighting of the lamp to mark inauguration of the Conference. The members responded with booming approbation. The invocation also received overwhelming response by the House for the performance.

Shri. S. B. Rode, General Secretary, AICBOF, in his welcome speech, briefed the organizational stand on several issues that are pertinent in the present scenario of transformation of the Banking structure. While welcoming Shri Jawadekarji & other dignitaries on & off the dias, General Secretary has taken a review of Golden Jubilee Celebrations with a information that Curtain Raiser function was arranged at Mumbai on 22nd February 2014 with subsequent celebrations at our affiliate units. It is a matter of pride for us that the Grand finale of Golden Jubilee Celebration is taking place at Pune in the presence of Shri. Jawadekarji, union Minister who hails from Pune. Mr. Rode also briefly touched upon the problems that the officers are facing and the need to find amicable solutions thereof such as unregulated working hours, Five Days week, FDI in insurance, New licenses to private sector banks etc. He briefed the

Honorable Minister on the various issues that are pending with the Government / IBA and has sought urgent intervention by the Honorable Minister , so as to settle bipartite agreement, pending for more than two years. He also invited the attention of the House to the immense contribution made by public sector bank officers for mobilizing 11.50 crore accounts under "Jan Dhan Yojana" in shortest time & which was recorded by the Guinness Book of World Records.

Shri Prakash Jawadekarji, Union Minister for Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Chief Guest of the function, recalled his earlier association with Banking Industry and the active role played by him in the tribal area of Thane, Maharashtra as a Bank Person. He categorically stated that "Jan Dhan Yojana" is an extremely important stepping stone in Financial Inclusion & thereby PSBs have participated in Nation Building Process. He also emphasized the need for carrying forward the banking facilities to poor class and also extend a support to young enterpruners who are always loyal in repayment. There were thunderous applause when the Minister clearly stated that the officer community can not be held responsible for the mounting NPAs and the weak financials of PSBs are the result of failure of big ticket accounts. Simultaneously, he rightly stated that clean air / clean water and clean energy would ultimately result in "CLEAN INDIA & GREEN INDIA." He responded to the issues of Bank officers stating that he will actively involve in wage revision process & the meaningful result will be there by the end of February 2015.

Mr.Harvinder Singh, G.S. AIBOC, in his key note address briefed organizational stand on several issues before the officers community of PSBs. While throwing light on wage revision, he informed that entire officer community have felt insult inflicted by IBA, Government and Finance Ministry by delaying the Wage Revision even after 15 rounds of discussions. He categorically mentioned that when the PSBs are required to fulfill social objectives which are imposed by Government, profitability should not be criteria for discussions. Even accepting profit as criterion, out of Rs. 36000 crores profit the additional impact of 10000 crores towards wage revision is most reasonable expectation. He stressed that it is primary responsibility of each one of us to play an active pivotal role against the challenges of merger, private sector banks, new licenses for opening banks, unlimited duty hours coupled with mounting NPAs & willful defaulters. The four days strike declared by UFBU has been kept on hold & shall be effected if Government does not amicably solve the issue. He appealed new generation officers to refer the website of AIBOC instead of believing on unauthentic messages spread by mischievous persons. He further appealed that in the absence of legal cover, unity & solidarity by showing our collective demonstrations will be the tools to get reasonable hike in the offer made by IBA. Apart from wage revision, AIBOC is serious about regulated working hours and five days week. Despite all the negative factors, he assured the gathering that there will be either respectable wage deal or further intensified action on our own & under the banner of AIBOC.

Mr. R.C.Agarwal, Ex President AIBOC, Ex General Secretary AICBOF, shared his rich experience in the industry by quoting various tricky incidences. He highlighted the difficult working conditions of the officers and frequent denial of several legitimate demands. The strike can not be legal & united we stand is the only weapon to achieve the goals. He touched the challenges that are ahead of the federation as the reforms in the banking industry needs to be fought.

In the midst of the inaugural session, the leadership of the Federation honoured all the past General Secretaries of the affiliate units as a token of love & affection for their valuable contributions to the trade union movement. It was a emotional moment for every one present in the hall to see former veteran leaders being adorned. A brief resume about the contributions made by these earlier generation stalwarts for the success of the trade union movement in our Bank was respected by the new generation officers. Mr. Lahane , Ex General Secretary Nagpur, while expressing his thanks on behalf of the veteran leaders honored on the occasion of Golden Jubilee, made a spirited appeal to fight injustice and atrocities inflicted on our membership by the management. Shri Lahane has rightly responded that "WE HAVE RESPONCIBILITY TO PRESERVE AND PROTECT UNITY FOR GREATER ACHIVEMENTS IN THE FUTURE"

Mr. A.K.Kansal, G.S.Delhi, proposed vote of thanks & the function concluded with National Anthem.

The inaugural session was concluded with a wonderful cultural programme by "Omkarshri", a renowned group who regaled the audience with their golden melodies.

On the 1st February 2015, at 10.30 a.m. Shri S.C.Gupta, the President of Federation took the chair and advised to initiate the business session. In his opening speech he drew the attention of Delegates & Observers to the challenges that are

The elections process was conducted very smoothly as there was only one panel under the leadership of Mr. S.B.Rode and this panel was declared elected unanimously for the next term. They also appreciated the pains taken by the CBOA Pune team in making the stay at Pune very comfortable.
